<u>Decorators Caulk</u> Product Information Sheet

Description

Decorators Caulk is a flexible water based filler and sealant that is easy to apply, dries quickly and can be over painted after 1 to 2 hours. Available in two sizes standard and trade. Standard colour is white but trade is available in white, magnolia or brown.

Uses

Decorators Caulk can be used for the sealing and filling of gaps or cracks where movement can occur such as between plaster work, window frames, doorframes, skirting boards and architraves. Use prior to painting or papering to prevent unsightly cracks developing at a later stage.

Directions

Surfaces must be clean and dust free. Remove the tip of the cartridge with a sharp knife. Cut the nozzle to the required joint size. Insert the cartridge into a standard sealant gun. Gun sealant firmly into the gap or crack. Smooth using a slightly wet stick or spatula. Uncured sealant can be removed with water. Flexible Decorators Caulk can be over painted with emulsion paint after 1 to 2 hours providing a skin has formed on the surface of the sealant. For oil based paints allow 24 hours before paining. Clean tools with water after use.

Smooth off while wet. Store in cool dry conditions. Protect from frost.
