Surface Preparation:	Surfaces to be painted must be in sound condition. Use in accordance with good painting practice. Remove grease and flaking material. Treat powdery surfaces with Fleetwood Masonry Primer. Surfaces to be painted must be sound, clean, dry and free from all defective or poorly adhering material, dirt, grease and salts. New plaster and masonry must be fully dry before priming. Avoid the inhalation of dust. Wear a suitable face mas dry sanding. Special precautions should be taken during surface preparation or pre-1960s paint surfaces over wood and metal as they may contain harmful lead.		
Application:	Brush, roller, spray & airless spray. As with other water-based paints, do not apply in temperatures below 5°C		
Spreading Rate:	As a guide, a coverage rate of up to 12m² /litre can be achieved under normal conditions		
Reduction:	Reduce by up to 20% as required by application and or equipment. When applying over previously painted matt surfaces, it is good practice to apply the 1st coat at 10% dilutions.		
Spray Recommendations:	Conventional Spray: Satisfactory through most equipment. Airless Spray: A typical recommendation for airless spray application is a minimum working pressure on paint of 140 kg/cm2 (2000 lb/in2) with a spray tip size of 0.38mm to 0.46mm (15 - 18thou) spray tip angle 65°. Filter mesh 60		
Drying Time:	Touch Dry: 30 minutes		
	Recoat: 2 – 4 hours		
	This is dependent upon temperature and humidity. Darker colours may take longer 26°C to 50% RH @ 100 μm		
Cleaning Up:	Clean up with soap and water. After cleaning up be sure to flush spray equipment with solvent to prevent rusting following manufacturer's instructions. The proper disposal of waste or unwanted paints is crucial to prevent environmental releases. This product must be disposed of in an authorised waste treatment facility, according to national laws. Packaging must also be sent to an authorised waste treatment facility for disposal, according to national laws.		
Tinting Instructions:	Tint only with Fleetwood Tinting systems		
Previously Painted Surfaces:	Keep out of reach of children. Ensure good ventilation during application and drying. If the product comes in contact with the eyes rinse immediately with plenty of water. To remove splashes from skin, use soap and water or a recognised skin cleaner. Do not take internally. Contains no added lead.		
Precautions:	If in sound condition, clean the surface of all foreign material Glossy surfaces must be rubbed down to provide a key. If paint is peeling or badly weathered, clean to sound substrate and treat as new.
