Surface Preparation:	Use in accordance with good painting practice. Remove oil, grease and flaking material. Surfaces to be painted must be sound, clean, dry and free from all defective or poorly adhering material, dirt, grease and salts. New plaster and masonry must be fully dry before priming. Treat powdery surfaces with Fleetwood Masonry Primer. Repair cracks and defective areas, and treat fungal or algal growth with Fleetwood Fungicidal Wash as required.		
Application:	Brush, roller, spray & spray. However, for H&S reasons related to all solvent-based paints, spray application is not recommended.		
Spreading Rate:	As a guide, a coverage rate of up to 6.5m <sup>2</sup> per litre, per coat, depending on the smoothness of the substrate

If the product comes in contact with the eyes, rinse immediately with plenty of water. To remove splashes from skin, use soap and water, or a recognised skin cleanser. Do not take internally.
